Thank you for your email of Tuesday 5 May regarding the meeting with BSSS Officers and ATESOL members that occurred on Monday 4 May to discuss the Draft English Framework.

Subsequently, the Framework developers reconvened specifically to analyse the feedback provided by members of ATESOL, as the consultation period had closed, and all other feedback had already been examined. As a result of this process, the developers provided responses to the feedback from ATESOL members and made amendments to the Framework where applicable. All feedback and the response to this feedback by the Framework development team was compiled into a Public Consultation Report.

The Draft English Framework, including the Public Consultation Report, was reviewed by the BSSS Curriculum Advisory Committee. The BSSS Curriculum Advisory Committee recommended the English Framework for Board Endorsement. Members commended the thorough attention and the considered responses to the issues raised in the consultation process.
