Guarantee education, training and employment pathways for educationally vulnerable Indigenous, migrant and refugee youth



Equip all pre-service teachers to cater for EAL/D learners in their classrooms



Revive specialist EAL/D teacher education programs



Rebuild EAL/D professional learning, leadership and school development



Institute systematic, national, evidence-based teacher workforce planning that includes EAL/D specialist teachers



Fast track post-pandemic EAL/D pedagogies of recovery



Implement a nationally agreed measure and method of reporting English language proficiency



Ensure transparency and accountability in the allocation and use of the English language proficiency loading



Review reporting, accountability and implementation of international student programs in Australian schools
